



# City of Monte Vista's Adult Sports Participant Code of Conduct

Registrations are not accepted until participant/parent(s) review and sign the Code of Conduct below.

## Parents and Spectators Will:

1. Remain in the spectator area during competitions. No spectators allowed on the "bench" and should only talk with the players before and after the game, unless called to the field/court of play due to an injury.
2. Let Referees ref.
3. Keep comments positive to players, parents, officials, and coaches of either team.
4. Be a role model, please refrain from use of tobacco, alcohol, and any other drugs during the events. This includes all electronic devices.
5. Cheer for your team.
6. Show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your child/friend/parent/etc.
7. Be in control of your emotions.
8. Help when you're asked to by a coach or an official.
9. Thank the coaches, officials, and other volunteers who conducted the event.

## Participants/Spectators Behavior

Each season all Participants/Spectators must sign the Code of Conduct in order to be able to participate in the program. You are responsible for your own behavior, as well as spectators who are there to cheer on you. Please set a good example for our kids that are watching. PLAYERS AND COACHES ARE ROLE MODELS and their behavior should reflect this.

The City of Monte Vista Recreation Department is committed to promoting the general health, welfare, and well-being of our community as well as being positive role models for our youth. Consequently, it is our policy that all participants and spectators shall not be permitted to use, be under the influence of, possess, distribute, gift, purchase, exchange, or sell any tobacco product, including electronic smoking devices, alcohol, or illegal drugs while participating in the city of Monte Vista's recreational activities and or sporting events

Parents, participants, and spectators are all expected to conduct themselves in a respectable, responsible, honest, and caring way. The City of Monte Vista has a no tolerance policy for behavior that is disrespectful, disruptive or rude. We will not hesitate to ask someone to leave the gym and/or facility for inappropriate behavior, failure to do so, appropriate authorities will be called.

**City Staff, employee and officials have the authority to ask any spectator or coach, who does not display conduct consistent with the City of Monte Vista's policies, to leave the game site. If a player's or spectator's behavior is egregious and disrupting any event, this includes inappropriate comments to the officials, staff, or other participants. The staff or officials are empowered to eject the offending parties as well as participating player (if necessary) from the event. If a person does not leave the grounds when asked, the police may be called to facilitate their departure. Such behavior may result in the players being dis-enrolled from the program with no refund to the player(s).**
